LASER BIATHLON SCHOOLS PROGRAM

The NSW Biathlon Schools Laser Biathlon program allows schools to access laser rifles during summertime.

The use of laser rifle equipment in NSW is exempt from firearms regulations for the purposes of biathlon and modern pentathlon. Any use of laser equipment must comply with and be used under this charter. NSW Biathlon, as the recognised peak body for biathlon in NSW, is a permitted user of laser biathlon equipment systems in NSW. Registration of events and attendees ensures compliance with NSW Firearms regulations

- 1) School joins NSW Biathlon as an Associate Member – Cost \$25

- 2) School nominates a parent(s) or teacher(S) as the responsible supervisor/coordinator to be trained in the use of the laser biathlon rifle(s).
- 3) Volunteers to assist with school programs (including school supervisor/coordinator) register as Volunteer members of NSW Biathlon ensuring they are covered by NSW Biathlon's 3rd party liability insurance.

- 4) School events and programs can either be registered in the NSW Biathlon website or advised by email to NSW Biathlon (ie weekly sessions) to ensure equipment use is covered for insurance purposes and names of attendees are recorded for NSW Firearms Registry purposes.
- 5) Events which are registered on the NSW Biathlon website can be set up to include waiver's, collection of medical information and booking fees (if any).
